INTRODUCITON

The National Service Scheme (NSS), established in 1969, was launched with the objective of fostering the personality development of students through meaningful community service, while simultaneously contributing to the development of rural areas in India. The introduction of NSS units in colleges was envisioned as a way to cultivate a strong sense of social responsibility among students and to nurture the values of self-discipline, dedication, and commitment toward community welfare.

In alignment with this vision, the NSS Unit of Deogiri Institute of Technology and Management Studies (DITMS), Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, under the guidance of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, organized a Special NSS Camp from 5 January 2026 to 11 January 2026 at Balapur (Taluka and District: Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar)

. The central theme of the camp was *“Youth for Sustainable Development of India – Special Reference to Watershed and Water Management.”*

The camp was designed to inspire active student participation in community-based initiatives and to promote holistic development. Through structured activities such as Shramdan (voluntary labor), awareness rallies, intellectual sessions, cultural programmes, and discussions on socially relevant issues, the program sought to strengthen qualities such as self-reliance, leadership, character building, and social commitment. 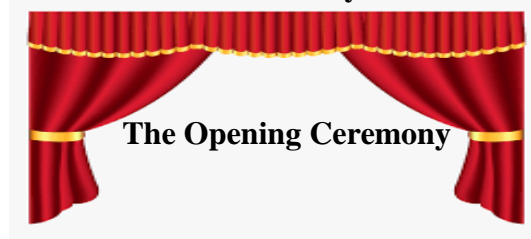

The camp was organized with the theme Youth for Sustainable Development of India with special reference to watershed and water management.

On the first day, the volunteers reached the camp site in the morning as per the schedule. Before the formal inauguration, the NSS volunteers undertook Shramdaan by cleaning and arranging the Gram Panchayat Hall provided for the residential camp. The hall was cleaned thoroughly and made suitable for accommodation, symbolizing the true spirit of service and dedication with which the camp began.

Inauguration and Awareness Rally

Day 2

6 January 2026, Tuesday

Cleanliness Drive and Knowledge Sessions

The second day of the NSS Seven Day Special Camp at Balapur village began at 6.00 am with yoga as per the regular camp schedule. The volunteers assembled on time and performed various yogasanas to maintain physical fitness and discipline. After yoga, tea and breakfast were served between 8.30 am and 9.00 am. At 9.00 am, prayer was conducted, followed by the NSS song and pledge, creating a sense of unity and dedication among the volunteers.

At 9.30 am, a Prabhat Pheri was organized in the village to spread awareness on social and environmental issues. The volunteers raised slogans related to cleanliness, water conservation, tree plantation, prevention of child marriage, and voter awareness. The rally helped in strengthening communication between the volunteers and the villagers.

From 10.30 am to 2.00 pm, Shramdaan was carried out as the major activity of the day. The volunteers conducted a cleanliness drive in Balapur village. The premises of the Zilla Parishad School and nearby public areas were cleaned. Roads, open spaces, and community spots were swept and cleared to promote hygiene and sanitation awareness. 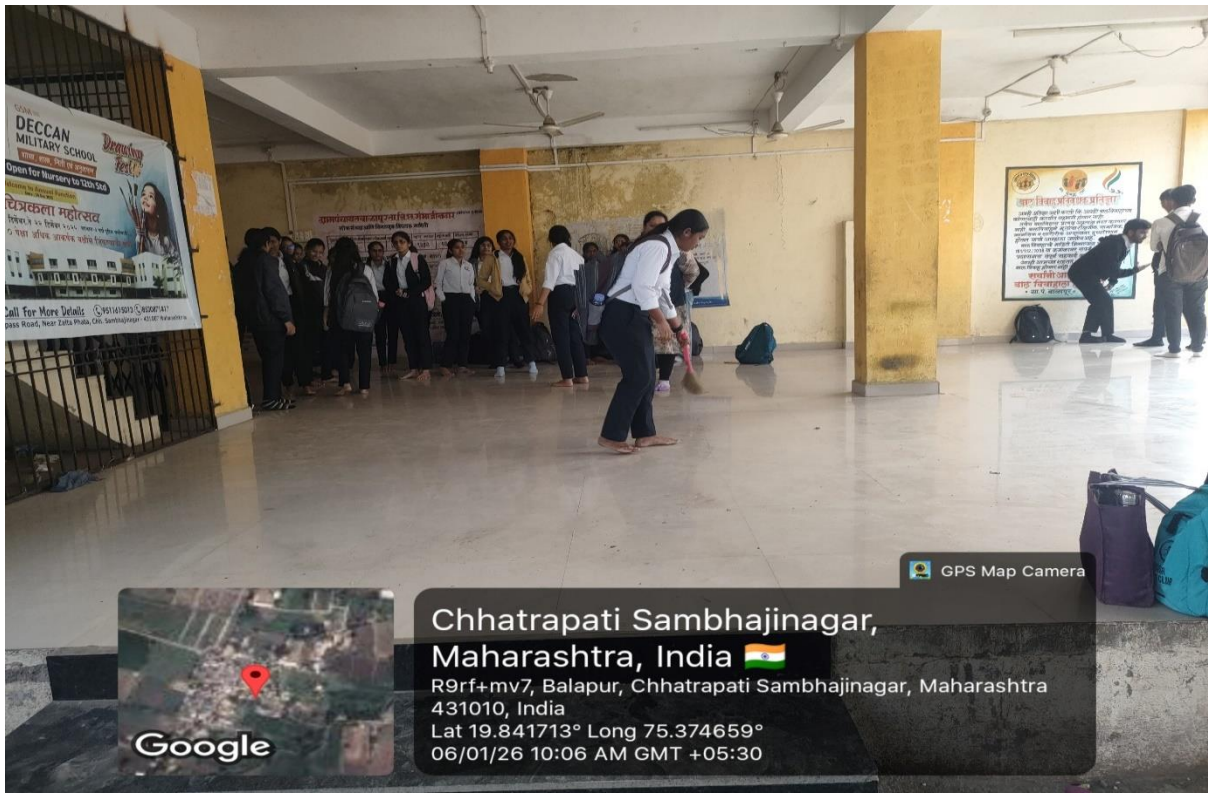
Faculty members including Professor Mrs. Pallavi Dhakore were present throughout the day and guided the volunteers in their activities.

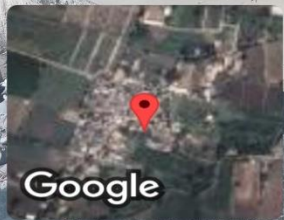
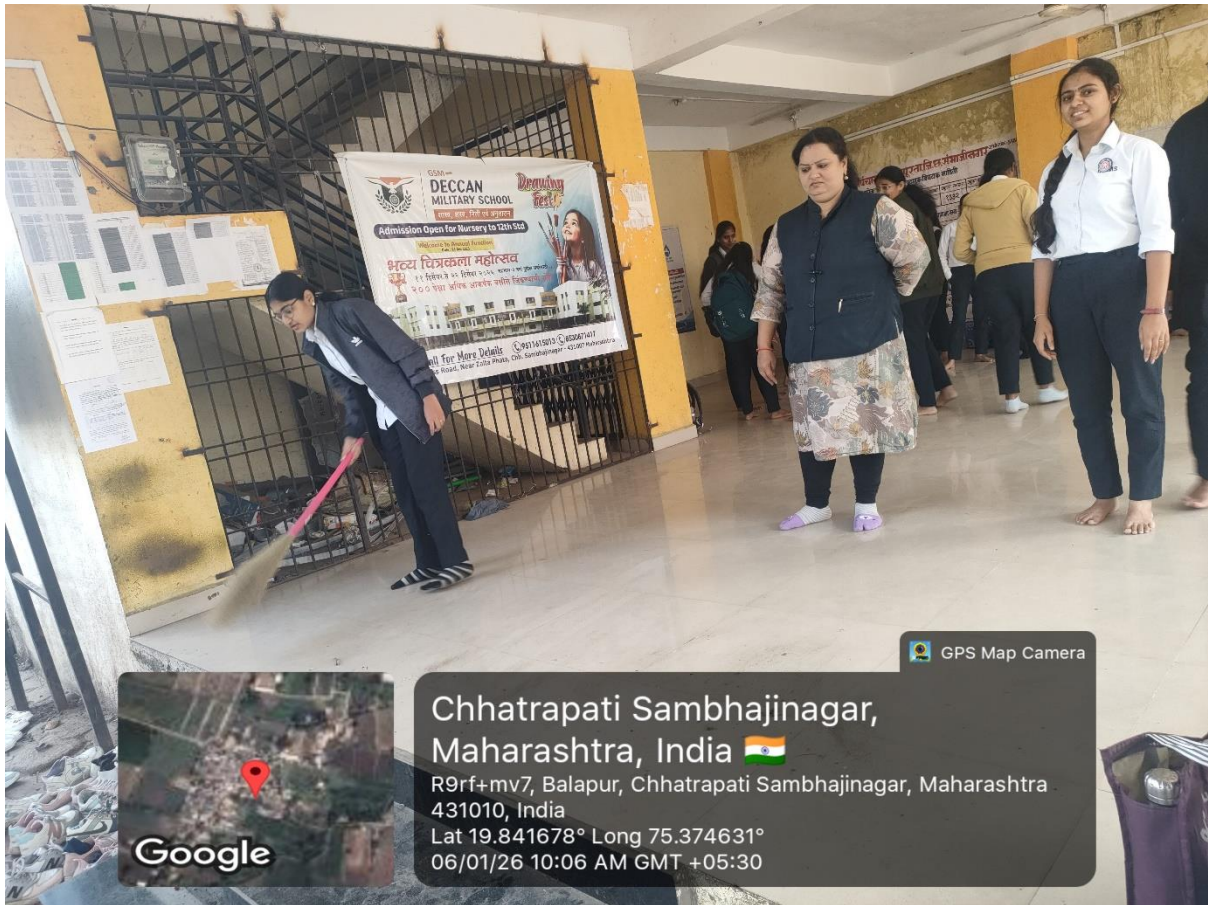

Visit to AURIC City Maha Expo, Shendra
